In team-based primary care, you receive coordinated, comprehensive care that is delivered by providers whom you get to know and trust. Team-based care prevents visits to the emergency room, and is best for managing complex and chronic health challenges.

After-Hours Care*

Summerville Family Health Team recognizes that medical issues may arise outside of regular clinic hours. After-hours clinics are available for URGENT issues at rotating sites. Clinics run Monday to Friday, 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. After-hours clinics are available to all Summerville patients and are not site specific. If immediate advice is needed, please call 811 to speak to a qualified health professional, such as a registered nurse, day or night.
